I travel to work up and down mort lane daily and experience heavier and heavier traffic along its length, especially at the junction with sale lane where the traffic comes to a standstill. Mosley common Rd is even worse. The main public transport system in the area is the guided busway. Again, with the volumes of new houses in the surrounding area this has become very very busy. My son, lives with me and works in central Manchester. The guided busway was a godsend to him when it opened as he was previously having to travel to walkden or atherton to catch the train. However now he has to leave the house at 7am just to make sure he gets on a bus. He doesn't actually start work until 8.30. Leaving the house any week day after 3pm going in any direction involves local queues of traffic locally. The local roads were not built for this amount of traffic. Myself and my partner walk weekly on these fields. We have less and less open land to walk on. We have considered this exercise on open land essential to our well being , especially over the past 18 months.
